Most of our students enter directly from their undergraduate school and apply to our Political Science Ph.D. program. Application deadlines are December 15 for both International and Domestic students for the following academic year.

Admission requirements:

Online application, (3) recommendation letters, official transcripts from all schools attended, CV, personal statement/statement of purpose (1 - 2 Pages), and sample of written work. GRE scores are required. International students must provide their TOEFL scores.
